Vaidya Narayan Jadhav from Udgir who attended this event told LIT "A total of 708 Ayurved practitioners and students from 22 states of India and Ayurveda practitioners from Nepal participated and read main classical Ayurveda text 'Charak Samhita' at a time for one hour and nine minutes."

He said this class created a world record by getting a place in the International Book of Records. The main objective of this event was to create interest about the ancient Ayurveda text like Charak Samhita among Ayurveda students.

Ayurveda is an ancient medical science of Indian origin. It is a science which takes care of not only getting relief from various mental and physi-

cal illnesses, but also focusses on aspect of preventive medicine.

Charak Samhita is Sanskrit text on Ayurveda. It is one of the fundamental Hindu texts of this field which has survived from ancient India. It describes ancient theories on human body, etiology, symptomology and therapeutics for the wide range of diseases.

The Charak Samhita also includes sections on the importance of diet, hygiene, prevention, medical education, teamwork of a physician, nurse and patient necessary for the recovery of health, he added.

## 10. Re-orientation Training Programme on Panchkarma therapy:

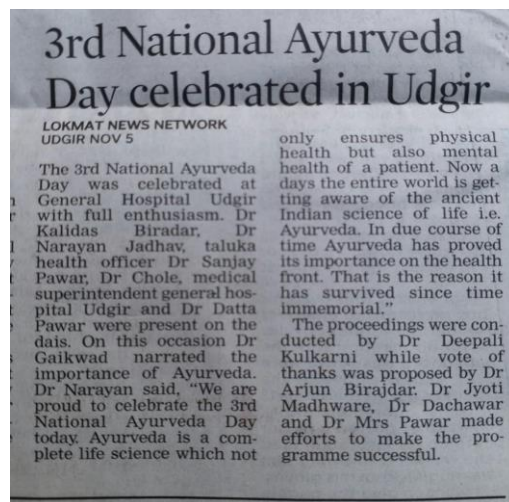

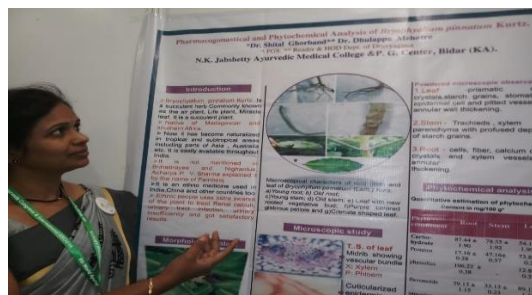

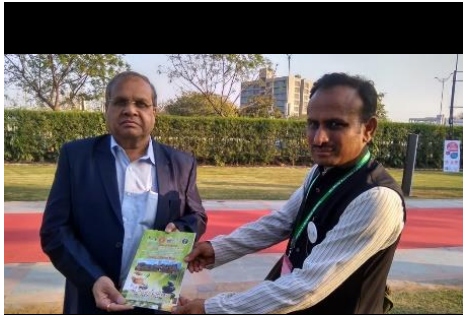
